AUGUST LOOSE CHANGE OFFERING BENEFITS MESSY CHURCH

AUGUST ELECTION ALERT

Did you know there is a special election on August 8, 2023 with only one issue on the ballot? Early voting has begun on State Issue 1, a proposed amendment which would make it much harder to change the Ohio Constitution by a citizen-led ballot initiative. If passed, it would raise the threshold for a successful proposal from a simple majority of 50% + one to a supermajority of 60%.

The amendment also makes it drastically harder to qualify for the ballot in the first place, by requiring that a 5% threshold for signatures be reached in all 88 counties. Currently, the Ohio Constitution allows for an amendment proposal to be put before the voters if signature requirements are met in at least 44 counties. The "cure period" for collecting additional signatures would be eliminated.

The rules for amending the Ohio Constitution were adopted in 1912 at a special state convention where Theodore Roosevelt gave the keynote address. He advocated strongly for the citizens of Ohio to have this right to direct democracy. 
